Keeps your cropping options open. The following crops can be seeded the year after applying Barricade® M herbicide: alfalfa, barley, canola, corn, dry beans, flax, forage grasses, lentils, mustard, oats, peas, potatoes, rye, soybeans, sugar beets, sunflowers and wheat.

When and how is Barricade® M herbicide applied?

The window of application for Barricade® M herbicide is from the 3-leaf stage to just before flag leaf. One case of Barricade® M herbicide treats 40 acres. Each case contains a dry herbicide in a 486-gram jug and two liquid herbicide jugs. Add a registered non-ionic surfactant (NIS) at 2 L per 1000 L of spray solution (0.2% v/v).
