Authority Supreme herbicide in early preplant or preemergence sets the bar as the new foundational herbicide to prevent early flushes of resistant weeds like waterhemp and Palmer amaranth. It is effective against ALS, triazine, HPPD, glyphosate and other PPO herbicide-resistant weeds that threaten soybean, sunflower and dry pea yields.

Application Timing:

Preplant and preemergence: Preplant, up to 45 days prior to plant through preemergence, up to 3 days after planting.

Product Use Rate:

Soybeans: 6 - 11.5 fl. oz./A

Sunflowers: 5.8 - 15.4 fl. oz./A

Dry peas: 4.3 - 15.4 fl. oz./A

Restrictions:

In dry shelled peas including chickpeas, do not apply more than the maximum cumulative amount listed for your soil type on the product label.

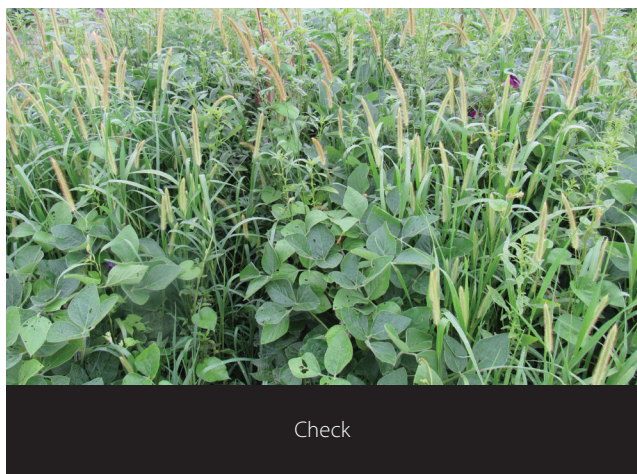

Label:

Active Ingredients: Pyroxasulfone (Group 15), sulfentrazone (Group 14)

Mode of Action: Contains two modes of action: Pyroxasulfone, which acts to inhibit very-long-chain fatty acid synthesis, is a root and shoot inhibitor that controls susceptible germinating seedlings before or soon after they emerge from the soil. Sulfentrazone acts as a protoporphyrinogen oxidase (PPO IX) enzyme inhibitor.
