PROGRAM RULES AND CONDITIONS

- Growers who purchase a minimum of 40 acres of FMC in-crop cereal herbicides and purchase the corresponding eligible product Belchim Manipulator® plant growth regulator between November 1st, 2023 and October 31st, 2024 will qualify for the rebate outlined above.
- Only eligible products listed in the table above are entitled for the program. Products other than those outlined above do not qualify. A minimum of 40 acres of any 2. combination of FMC In-Crop cereal herbicides is required to qualify for the program.
