



A head start this fall gets you cleaner fields next spring

Applying Express® brand herbicides plus glyphosate in the fall is the best time to prevent the establishment of hard-to-control weeds.

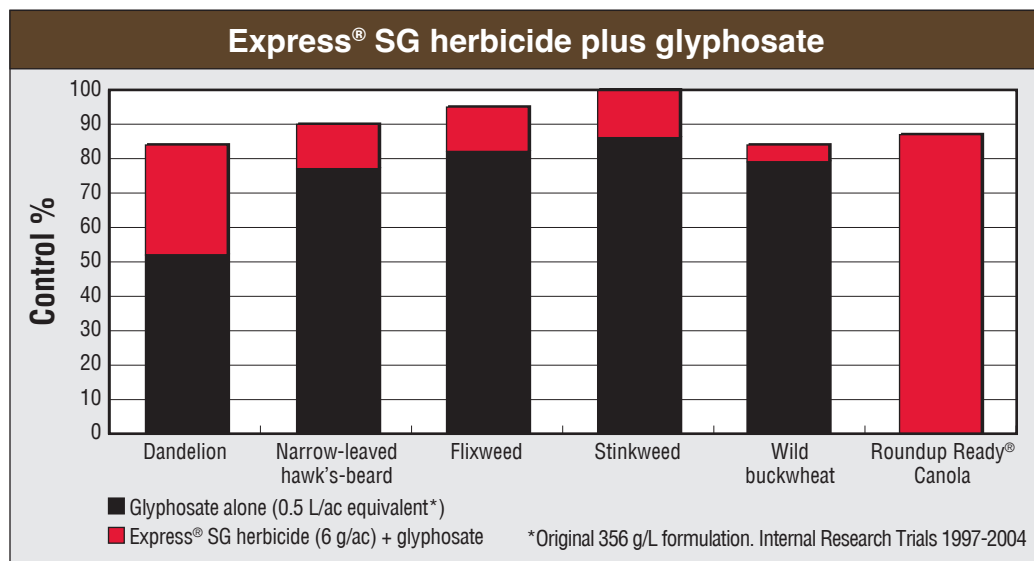
Why is fall the best time to control weeds?

- In the fall, tough weeds like dandelion and narrow-leaved hawk's-beard transfer water and nutrients to their roots to prepare for winter. A systemic herbicide takes advantage of this movement for better control.
- Winter annuals such as flixweed, stinkweed and shepherd's purse will germinate in the fall and are more difficult to control in the following spring once established.
- Field conditions, weather or workload can delay or prevent a burnoff application next spring.

Why should I add Express® brand herbicides to my glyphosate?

- Glyphosate controls many weeds, but not all, and regrowth is common. Express® brand herbicides control many tough weeds right to the root, preventing regrowth.
- Using glyphosate alone can, over time, lead to resistance issues. Adding Express® brand herbicides provides additional modes of action, protecting your future glyphosate use.

As shown below, adding Express® SG herbicide to glyphosate provides enhanced weed control vs glyphosate alone.

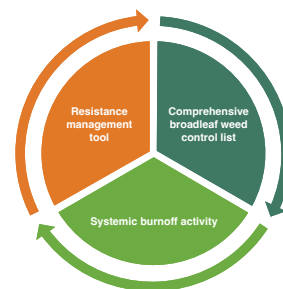
Seed winter wheat 24 hours after fall application

Powerful post-harvest burndown plus extended activity

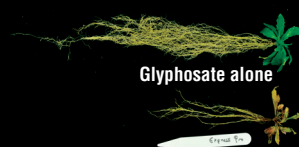
- Active ingredients: Tribenuron-methyl, metsulfuron-methyl, dicamba
- Registered for post-harvest applications ahead of spring wheat, durum wheat, winter wheat, barley and oats
- Systemic control of tough emerged weeds like kochia, cleavers, dandelion, narrow-leaved hawk's-beard and volunteer canola
- **Extended control* of certain weeds such as germinating dandelion and volunteer canola***
- Activity down to the root, helping prevent regrowth while reducing weed pressure heading into spring
- Limit of one application of Express® FT herbicide (or other products containing metsulfuron-methyl) per 12-month period



For resistance management

- Active ingredients: Tribenuron-methyl, dicamba
- Provides three modes of action, Groups 2, 4 and 9, when combined with glyphosate to help fight resistance
- Comprehensive broadleaf control: Kochia (including Group 2 resistant biotypes), dandelion, flixweed, narrow-leaved hawk's-beard, stinkweed, volunteer canola
- When applying post-harvest, next spring you can seed oats, spring barley and wheat (spring or durum). If planning to seed canola, field corn, soybean, lentil or white bean the following spring after a post-harvest application of Express® FX herbicide, apply prior to October 1st

For extended control

- Active ingredients: Tribenuron-methyl, metsulfuron-methyl
- Extended control* of germinating dandelion, volunteer canola*, narrow-leaved hawk's-beard and cleavers
- When applying post-harvest, seed only spring wheat, durum wheat, oats and barley the following spring
- Limit of one application of Express® PRO herbicide (or other products containing metsulfuron-methyl) per 12-month period

A burnoff that scorches weeds right down to the roots and keeps them from bouncing back!
