Spill or leak	Prevent er containers spreading.	DO NOT touch or walk through spilled material. Wear PVC overalls, chemical resistant gloves, facemask or goggles. Stop leak when safe to do so. Prevent entry into waterways, drains, or confined areas. Small Spill: Pick up with sand or other non-combustible absorbent material and place into containers for later disposal. Large Spill: Dike far ahead of liquid spill for later disposal. Cover powder spill with plastic sheet or tarp to minimize spreading. Prevent entry into waterways, drains or confined areas. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Absorb and collect washings and place in the same sealable container for disposal. Seek advice from the local authority regarding disposal.
