IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
Tanker/Vehicle Accident	Switch off engine. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Call the emergency services: Dial 111
Spill or leak	Keep all bystanders away. Wear goggles, half face-piece respirator with combined dust and vapour cartridge, full length clothing and PVC gloves. Prevent further spillage. Absorb spilled product and place in a sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Seek advice from the local authority regarding disposal.
Fire	Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. This product is combustible. Decomposition products in a fire are toxic or irritant. Wear PVC protective clothing and breathing apparatus. Extinguish fires with foam, dry chemical or carbon dioxide or fine water spray. During a fire toxic fumes may be produced. Cool sealed drums with water to prevent rupture due to thermal expansion. Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away.

If Swallowed	DO NOT induce vomiting. For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately.
If in Eyes	Hold eyelids apart and flush the eye continuously with running water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention.
If on Skin	If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water. Do not scrub the skin.
If Inhaled	Remove patient to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-nose. Get medical attention if symptoms develop.

STORAGE AND SEGREGATION SUMMARY

Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry, ventilated place away from direct heat or direct sunlight. Store away from foodstuffs, animal feed, children and animals. Keep container sealed when not in use.
