



Maple DF

A micronutrient for agricultural crops formulated as a water-dispersible granule

Manganese (Mn) soluble in water: 310 g/kg Sulphur trioxide (SO₃): 450 g/kg

PATES OF LISE

Apply 2.5 - 5 kg/ha in at least 200 litres of water.

Repeat applications may be necessary as advised or recommended by analysis.

Subclinical (maintenance) dressing: 1 kg/ha twice during Spring / Summer period.

Water volume

For best results, apply Maple DF in at least 200 litres of water. Do not use less than 200 l/ha if Maple DF is to be applied in tank mix with other products.

TIMING

Cereals:

In the Autumn as soon as there is sufficient leaf present to absorb the spray and repeat in the spring when growth re-commences.

Oilseed rape:

In the Autumn prior to dormancy and again in the Spring at the onset of growth.

Potatoes

Apply with the first blight sprays. Repeat applications with later blight sprays at half-rate will be beneficial.

Sugar beet:

Apply at 4 – 6 leaf.

Peas and beans:

In areas of known deficiency, apply when the crop is 10 – 15 cm high. If symptoms persist, repeat at flowering and again 7 – 10 days later.

It is recommended that soil and tissue analysis results are used whenever possible to guide micro and macronutrient applications to optimise crop nutrient status. Do not apply this product in very bright sunlight or in temperatures above 25°C. If possible, spray in the evening or early morning for best results.

APPLICATION

Do not premix.

Half fill the spray tank with water, begin agitation and proceed as follows:

Induction Bowls - pass required amount of product slowly through the bowl whilst on constant flow setting.

Top Filling - wash required amount of product through top filter.

Complete the filling and apply without delay. Maintain agitation throughout.

Clean sprayer thoroughly after use.

COMPATIBILITY

STORAGE
