

FMC Overlapping Residual Herbicide Assurance Guidelines:

The FMC Overlapping Residual Soybean Assurance Program is designed to encourage growers to use sound weed management by applying residual herbicides before soybean emergence and, then follow with a second residual herbicide in combination with a postemergence (POST) herbicide before weeds reach 4-inches tall within 30 days of soybean emergence. Growers who follow the FMC Overlapping Residual Soybean Herbicide Assurance recommendations at the minimum specified rate depending on use timing (see table below) will be eligible for an assurance payment up to \$15.00/A if the treatment does not maintain commercially acceptable 90% control of labeled weeds versus an untreated check within 15 days after the early post application. The assurance funds are to be used toward a clean-up application to achieve acceptable weed control. The assurance claim must be reported within 15 days after the early post application. Spring preplant or preemergence applications must include labeled rates of Roundup® + 1.0 pt./A of 2,4-D or dicamba w/wo 1.0 fl. oz./A of Aim® EC herbicide to control emerged weeds. Follow all appropriate plant-back restrictions when using 2,4-D and dicamba products in soybeans according to labeling and soybean trait package.

Program Requirements:

- 1. A grower must complete both parts of a two-pass weed control program specified above before assurance program/claim is in effect. If inadequate weed control is attained <u>after</u> the in-crop application is made, then FMC will investigate claim.
- 2. An authorized FMC representative must be notified of a claim within 15 days after the early post application is made, prior to the established deadline and have a reasonable opportunity to inspect prior to any additional product applications. The authorized FMC representative must confirm inadequate product performance.
- 3. Assurance benefit is for product costs only. Application and other related costs are excluded from assurance payments.
- 4. Leave a representative check strip in each field for comparison and mark its location.
- 5. Products must be applied according to label use directions and in accordance with local FMC recommendations.
- 6. Growers/retailers must provide proof that all products were applied at appropriate timing where sequential application programs are recommended.
- 7. Record and save product lot or batch numbers.

Program Payment Date: 30 days after claim submission to FMC
