Program Description:

Mustang® Maxx insecticide provides fast, effective control of a wide variety of rice insect pests including rice stink bugs. When Mustang Maxx insecticide is applied according to the label and the following guidelines and a retreatment is required based on rice stink bugs exceeding the economic threshold within seven days as set forth below, which such determination shall be made solely by an FMC representative or an FMC authorized agent. FMC will reimburse up to 4.0 fl. oz. of Mustang Maxx insecticide/A or \$5.00/A whichever is less for a second 4 fl. oz./A Mustang Maxx insecticide application. FMC must be notified prior to retreatment and within seven days after the first application.

Program Period: June 1, 2020 – September 30, 2020

Program Geography: Arkansas, Louisiana, Mississippi, Missouri (Bootheel) and Texas

Program Submission: FMC must be notified prior to retreatment and within 7 days after the first

application.

Program Qualifications:

The application should be made just prior to the insect population reaching the economic threshold* for rice stink bugs. The field application rate of Mustang Maxx insecticide must be at the labeled rate of 4 fl. oz./A (32 A/gal.) when rice stink bug populations approach treatment thresholds. Aerial applications must use a minimum of 5 gallons per acre (GPA) of final sdpray solution. Ground applications must use a minimum of 10 GPA final spray solution.

If, after the initial application, the field in question has an insect population greater than the economic threshold as outlined in these guidelines, then the growers/dealers must notify their FMC representative within 48 hours when reporting a claim so the field may be scouted for approval of the second treatment. Receipts and documentation of product purchase and application will be required for both applications before payment is made.

Program Rules & Conditions:

- 1. FMC reserves the right to change any or all features of this program at any time.
- 2. An authorized FMC representative must be notified of a claim prior to the established deadline and have a reasonable opportunity to inspect prior to any additional product applications. The authorized FMC representative must confirm inadequate product performance.
- 3. Proof of purchase is required. Only FMC branded products purchased from FMC authorized distributors or retailers and reported by Data Dimensions are eligible for payment under this program.
- 4. Only product purchased for resale to growers is eligible for payment under the terms of this program.
- 5. FMC reserves the right to audit all claims. Misreported sales of any type are a clear violation of this program and will be subject to audit and possible forfeiture of any and all program benefits.
