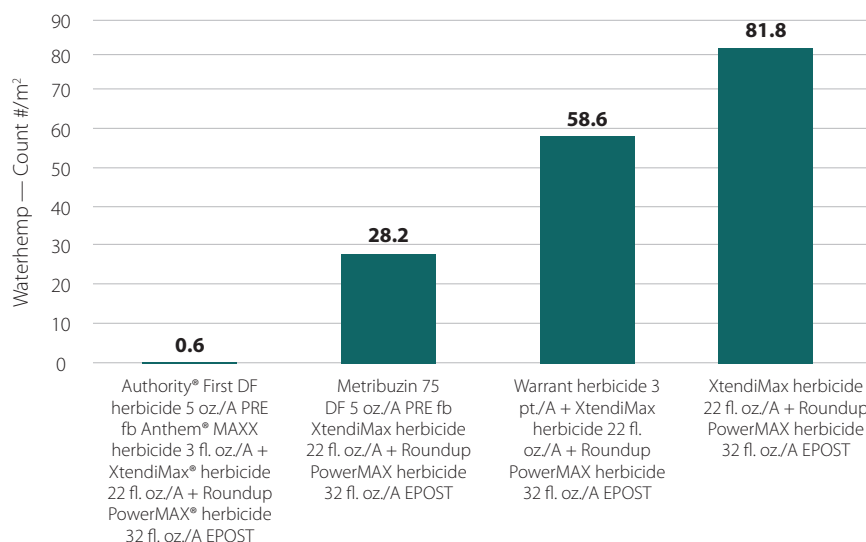

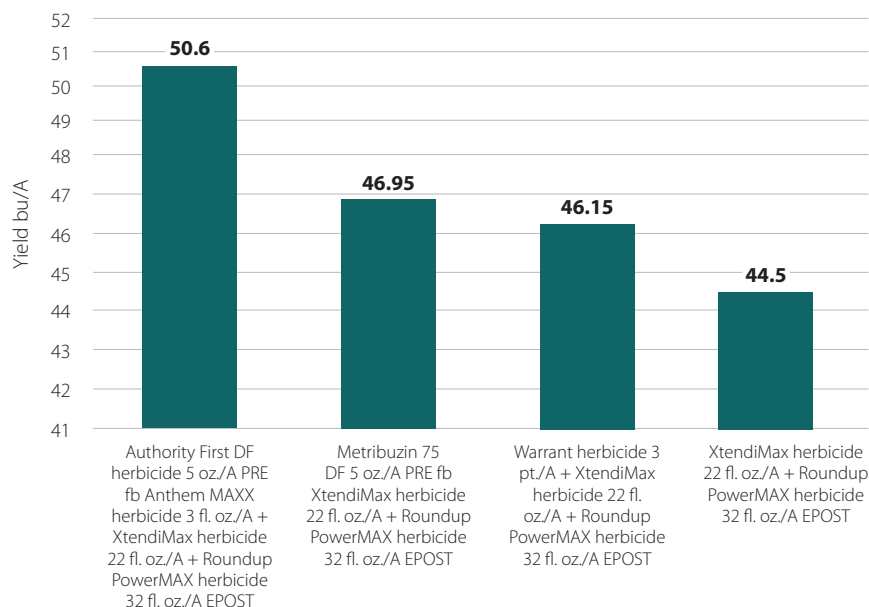


INFLUENCE OF USING MULTIPLE SOA ON SOIL SEEDBANK DYNAMICS OVER THREE YEARS

Crabgrass
Fall panicum
Foxtail
Palmer amaranth
Waterhemp

Application Timing:

Early postemergence through V6 soybean stage; apply in a tank mix with other post herbicides for broad-spectrum grass and broadleaf control.

Application Guidelines:

Preharvest Intervals: 60 days

Product Use Rates: 2.0 – 5.7 fl. oz./A

Restrictions:

Do not apply more than 0.0089 lb. ai/A of fluthiacet-methyl or 0.266 lb. ai/A of pyroxasulfone per acre in a 12-month cropping year including preplant burndown.
